#### **Unit expansion**

I would like to remind you of the plan for the rest of the half term as the unit expansion takes place starting on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> June. Therefore, over the next half term we are going to have builders and contractors on site: There will be no access around the back of the school and therefore, if dropping off in Reception and KS1, you will need to come back around to the front of the school. The whole area where the contractors will be working will be blocked off so no children can access the area. The contractors will have a compound area, where the current skip is, and all vehicle movement and deliveries will happen outside of school drop off times. All contractors will have full DBS certificates and will undergo school safeguarding procedures.
