Headteacher's comments

We are well and truly getting into the busiest part of the term. The school has been so busy with play practices, singing assemblies, parents lunches and coffee mornings. We really appreciate the parental engagement we are getting as it is so lovely to see so many of you engaging with the school. There are many dates for the diary so please do read the information below carefully to ensure you don't miss anything!

Walking safely to school / Road safety

Please remember to keep your children close when walking to school. This includes when you enter the school grounds as there are cars and taxis travelling down to the office area and the school car park.

Colder weather

As the weather has really taken a turn, please ensure your child is prepared with weather appropriate clothing such as coats, hats and gloves. Please also ensure these are clearly named. As it gets colder, please also be mindful of any icy patches and stick to the school paths as these will have been appropriately gritted.

School closures

As the weather starts to turn colder and there is a chance of snow, I wanted to reassure you that we would only close the school if we were unable to operate due to lack of staffing or there was a health and safety risk. If the weather is severe and we are forced to close the school, school will send out an in-app message to all parents and please refer to the school website.
